Leatherique[®] Rejuvenator Leather Conditioner #1 is an outstanding solution for revitalising, moisturising, and conditioning high-quality leather. Crafted from natural ingredients, it maintains leather fibres, resulting in a non-greasy, soft, and supple finish that protects against drying and cracking.

Materials

- Leatherique[®] Rejuvenator Leather Conditioner #1
- Microfibre cloth or paper towel
- Nitrile or latex gloves

Application

Vacuum the surface well or use a soft brush to remove large particles of dirt, paying particular attention to seams, folds and cracks.

Most leathers need at least two applications of Leatherique[®] Rejuvenator. The first to remove accumulated cleaners and oils already there, and the second to allow Rejuvenator to really start to work.

Shake the bottle well, ensuring thorough mixing of all ingredients before use. Note that Leatherique[®] Rejuvenator may experience slight clarity changes over time, with minor separation of soap and emulsifiers from leather nutrients.

Test a small inconspicuous area first, checking for any adverse reactions or colour removal.

Apply Rejuvenator liberally with a cloth, spray or your hands (with gloves if you have sensitive skin). You may also use a soft sponge or a soft paint brush.

Thoroughly massage Rejuvenator into all the surfaces, natural folds of the leather and stitched areas which allows it to migrate laterally into the hide. This puts the natural ingredients back into the leather opens the pores and forces out dirt.

Allow the Rejuvenator to be absorbed into the leather for a minimum of 1-2 hours. The leather will continue to absorb Rejuvenator until fully saturated. Multiple applications are recommended until the leather no longer absorbs Rejuvenator.

For "cardboard hard" leather, several applications will be necessary. Patience and multiple applications will be rewarded with good results.

After correct proteins and collagens from the Rejuvenator have permeated back into the pores and fibres of the leather, strengthening and nourishing them, the surface may be tacky, sticky, gritty, or have a white haze. This is simply the dirt, grime, air pollution, perspiration, salts and other toxins that have floated out of the leather to the surface.

Following use of Rejuvenator, use Leatherique[®] Pristine Clean to clean the dirt, grime, body oils and perspiration from your leather surface, leaving it clean without any greasy residue, unpleasant odours, or dryness.

Suede

To clean suede, use Leatherique[®] Rejuvenator only. Apply Rejuvenator with a microfibre cloth, let the suede sit to absorb the Rejuvenator, then buff with a cloth to restore the nap and remove the dirt. Because there is no protective finish on the leather for the dirt to pass through, it will be right there on the surface of the actual pile/hide and you can remove it with the buffing motion.

Regular Maintenance

Use Leatherique[®] Rejuvenator and Pristine Clean every 6 months to preserve your leather's beauty, and keep your leather soft, subtle and clean.

Warnings

- Not suitable for leather treated with silicone-based products and cleaners.
- May remove pigment from pre-war vegetable-dyed leather; consider Leatherique[®] Leather Dyes for recolouring.
- Test a small inconspicuous area on leathers/leatherettes coated or repaired with acrylic coating, as some acrylic coatings may lift off the leather.
