The low sheen finish has superb film properties for adhesion, coverage, hiding power and overall surface hardness. The highly durable, low odour, stain-resistant formulation is complemented with a 7 year mould and mildew protection guarantee making it ideal for interior walls and high traffic area's such as wet areas such as kitchens and bathrooms. The coating can also be tinted to a range of white base colours (tintable at full strength) to suit both commercial and domestic environments.

Where to Use

Suitably prepared brick, concrete, masonry, paper-faced plasterboard, set plaster, timber and pre-painted surfaces. All interior walls including high traffic areas such as; bathrooms, bedrooms, dining rooms, feature walls, hallways, laundries and living areas.

| General Surface Preparation | Fill cracks, nail holes and imperfections with Haymes Unifill. Scrape all loose/flaking paint. Sand smooth & dust down. All surfaces must be clean, bare, dry and free of wax, grease and other contaminants. Remove all traces of mould using a 10% bleach solution. Prime bare plaster, timber and metal areas with appropriate Haymes undercoats or primers. |
| Previously Painted Surfaces | Prepare any damaged areas as for General Surface Preparation. Apply one coat of Haymes Ultraseal to any patched areas. Sand gloss surfaces to a dull finish. Remove all dust For surfaces in good condition no primers or undercoats are required. |
| Plasterboard | Prepare any damaged areas as for General Surface Preparation. Apply one coat of Haymes Ultraseal |
| Timber | Prepare any damaged areas as for General Surface Preparation. Apply one coat of Haymes Ultracover |
| Masonry, Brick, Concrete, Render | Wash with Haymes Unikleen and rinse with clean water. Apply one coat of Haymes Ultraseal |

Application

- Do NOT apply if ambient temperature is less than 10°C or greater than 30°C or if conditions will drop below 10°C during the drying period. Under warmer conditions refer to Thinning advice.
- All times quoted assume ambient conditions of 25°C and 50% relative humidity. At cooler temperature or higher humidity drying times will be extended.
- Stir thoroughly before and during application.
- Apply two coats by brush, roller or spray.
- Application methods;

Brush: Use a quality synthetic brush

Roller: Use a 11-12 mm nap length on smooth to semi-smooth surfaces. A longer nap is required for textured or rough surfaces

Spray: For airless spray use a 15 – 17 thou @ 2000-2500 psi

(The use of low-pressure tips will require a lower pressure range.)

- Provide adequate ventilation during application and the drying period.
- Please check the colour for accuracy prior to application. Haymes Paint accepts no responsibility for the application of incorrect colours.

Thinning

Thinning is not recommended unless spraying; add up to 100ml clean water per litre of paint to achieve acceptable atomisation. Up to 50ml of water can be added per litre of paint to ease application under very warm conditions.

Care and Maintenance

New paintwork should not be exposed to steam or condensation for 72 hours. Protect the coating against abrasive contact for 7 days. After 7 days the finish can be cleaned with a mild detergent solution and a soft cloth.

Storage

Containers must be secured and stored upright during transit. Protect from extremes of temperature. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place and out of direct sunlight. Check regularly for leaks.

Warranty

Haymes Ultimate Anti-Bac Single-Pack is guaranteed for a period of 7 years to protect against mould and mildew growth. For this warranty to apply there must be extraction installed and used, that sufficiently removes all moisture vapour. Additionally Haymes Ultimate Anti-Bac Single-Pack must be applied to correctly prepared surfaces in accordance with Haymes specifications and all traces of mould must be completely removed prior to painting.

For the warranty to be valid Henry Haymes Pty Ltd must be notified within 30 days of the initiation of the alleged fault. Should the alleged fault prove to be due to faulty product to the satisfaction of Henry Haymes Pty Ltd, Henry Haymes Pty Ltd will provide, free of charge, sufficient paint to rectify the affected area.
