GENERAL DESCRIPTION

A water based premium quality, acrylic, flat paint for use on interior ceilings.

USES

Suitable for interior paper faced plasterboard and fibrous or set plaster.

COLOURS

Available in White which allows machine tinting to a wide range of fashionable colours. Tinter, if added, should be thoroughly stirred or shaken into the paint immediately upon addition. This product is not tint strength aligned, use only 75% of the tint formula or colours will appear darker.

SIZES

Available in 1 Litre, 4 Litre, 10 litre and 15 Litre.

COVERAGE

Up to 16 square meters per litre depending upon surface porosity and application method.

APPLICATION TOOLS

Roller, Brush or Airless Spray.


DRYING TIMES

Touch Dry Time – 20 minutes. Recoat Dry Time - 2 hours. Drying times refer to normal conditions (25°C, 50% humidity). Under cooler, humid or still conditions, longer drying times may be necessary.

DO NOT USE IN TEMPERATURES BELOW 10°C OR ABOVE 30°C.

Previously Painted Surfaces:

Scrape off loose and flaking paint, make sure the remainder is firmly attached, wash down to remove dirt, grease and mould with Haymes Unikleen Sugar Soap. Rinse with clean water, allow to dry and fill nail holes, cracks and imperfections with Haymes Unifill. Sand smooth and dust down. Apply one coat of Masterpiece Sealer Undercoat. Prime bare timber or metal areas with the appropriate primer.

New Paper Faced Plasterboard: Fill imperfections with Haymes Unifil, sand smooth and dust down. Apply one coat of Masterpiece Sealer Undercoat.

<u>Fibrous or Set Plaster:</u> Fill imperfections with Haymes Unifill, sand smooth and dust down. Apply one coat of Haymes Sealer Binder and allow to dry 16 hours prior to recoating.

FINISHING

Apply two coats of Haymes Masterpiece Ceiling White.

THINNING & CLEAN UP

Thinning is not recommended. If thinning required for spraying add up to 100ml of water per litre. Clean equipment with water immediately after use.

COATING CONDITIONS

Do not apply if the temperature is below 10°C or above 30°C. Provide adequate ventilation with good airflow. Avoid painting in direct sunlight.

STORAGE

Protect from extremes of temperature. Store between 5°C and 30°C.

PRECAUTIONS

- <u>Safety Directions:</u> Keep out of reach of children. DO NOT SWALLOW. Harmful: may cause lung damage if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear suitable, protective clothing, eye protection and impervious gloves when using. Harmful by inhalation.
