Touch dry in 10 minutes.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

## **SURFACE PREPARATION**

Surface must be free of dust, wax and rust. All bare timber should be undercoated and bare metal should be primed with metal primer. Newspapers or plastic drop sheets should be spread around work to protect adjoining areas from overspray.

#### **ADJUST THE SPRAY PATTERN**

The fan jet may be adjusted for horizontal or vertical spraying by turning the jet to the horizontal or vertical position.



## **SPRAY APPLICATION**

Applying several light coats rather than one heavy coat will achieve the best results. If a second coat is required, apply after 1 hour and before 2 hours. If this is not possible, wait 4 days before re-coating.

#### **AFTER USE**

Turn can upside down and spray until jet clears. Any overspray may be cleaned up with mineral turps.
