## **Description**

**PHOSS DET** is a clear liquid, which is a highly concentrated acidic foaming detergent sanitiser used for the foam cleaning of external surfaces in food preparation areas.

# **Application**

**PHOSS DET** is used for the removal of hard water calcium and lime deposits, soap scum, mineral stains and rust stains. Surfaces such as bricks, ceramic tiles and masonry surfaces would be suitable for cleaning and sanitizing with **PHOSS DET**.

The added detergency aids penetration of the acids into the surface to help lift other stains

**PHOSS DET** contains biodegradable surfactants. Always test **PHOSS DET** in a small, inconspicuous area, to ensure no detrimental effect on the surface to be cleaned.

#### **Directions**

PHOSS DET should be diluted 1:30 with cold water, depending on the nature of the surface. Pre-wet the surface before applying PHOSS DET to minimize the possibility of etching or discolouring the surface. Once prepared, apply the diluted solution of PHOSS DET and agitate the stained area with a scrubbing brush or pad to remove any stain. Rinse the cleaned area twice with potable water to remove all traces of detergent
