### Easy to Use:

Power steering units should be checked at least every six months and topped up where necessary. Although the fluid level may be checked hot or cold, it is recommended it be checked whilst hot.

If the power steering fluid is low, check your owner's manual for proper fluid specifications before adding fluid. Do not overfill.

Power Steering Fluid is not recommended for use in Honda power steering units. Always refer to owner's manual for correct lubricant recommendation.
